Job Purpose:

Senior Lead Engineer is a specialist role responsible for managing all TWMA equipment & subordinate personnel whilst on or offshore. This includes but is not limited to.

- Management & development of personnel.
- Conduct training on-site for new employees.
- Overseeing the day to day running of equipment & organisation of planned / unplanned maintenance.
- Support senior team members with data collection and continuous improvement projects.
- Ensure awareness and compliance with all operations, health and safety and quality assurance.
- Responsibility for all health, safety and environmental issues connected with the operation of TWMA equipment.
- Support and mentor existing & new employees.

Key Responsibilities:

Project Planning

- Assist the Engineering / Operations Department with the completion of rig surveys &offshore installations.
- Attend pre-project planning and 'spud meetings' if required.
- Assist with the compilation of end of well/project reports.
- Daily interface with the client representatives.
- Participate in the organisation of equipment load as required.
- Plan, supervise and assist equipment rig up in accordance with company and site-specific procedures.
- Plan, supervise and assist in the decommissioning of equipment at the end of the contract and in a safe and tidy manner.
- Plan, organise and ensure maintenance programme for equipment is in place and executed as required.
- Oversee daily requisitions of resources, equipment, consumables, PPE etc.

Knowledge Guidance and Coaching:

- Ensure all work carried out by the staff is to a high standard.
- Prioritisation of tasks & delegation of workload as necessary.
- Ensure safe working practices always are adopted by offshore Crew.
- Share knowledge and experience and pro-actively contribute to the ongoing learning and development of all personnel.
- Give constant feedback to the Crew on the planned activities and issues as they arise.

Project Management (Offshore and Onshore)

- Supervise and assist all personnel in the operating of TWMA equipment in line with company procedures.
- Identify ways of continually improving the way work is performed.

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Participate in Management Meetings.

HSEQ and regulatory compliance:

- Follow all TWMA, site and regulator procedures.
- Address any concerns and take appropriate actions in conjunction with TWMA procedures.
- Attend safety meetings with QHSE/Client personnel as required.
- Proactively contribute to all HSE aspects in compliance with directorate HSE plan.

- Diploma in Mechanical or Electrical Engineering or National Vocational Qualification (NVQ) in any relevant industry discipline with equivalent experience of at least 3 years if relevant qualification is not available (E)

- Basic Offshore Certifications Basic Offshore Survival Induction & Emergency Training (BOSIET)/ Basic H2S. (P)
- Certified Train the trainer (P)
- Formal competency assessor qualification (P)

- Minimum 7 years' experience in a similar role within the oil & gas/ energy industries or internal working experience in process equipment/ heavy plant machinery within TWMA and relevant competency assessment for the role complete (E).

- 5 years' experience working within onshore/ offshore drilling waste or process industries as related service or process provider (P)
- Proven experience in servicing & trouble shooting mechanical or electrical equipment/machinery
